- How has the cultural humility concept evolved over time?

## 2. Select Relevant Literature:

- > Cultural humility in the article/document title
- Keywords: theory, concept, model, conceptual, OR framework AND health, healthcare, medical, OR medicine
- > 56 articles from 1998 to 2022 fit the inclusion criteria

## 3. Collate & Synthesize the Literature:

- Assign a priori categories from founding cultural humility concept authors (Tervalon & Murray-Garcia, 1998) & develop emergent themes
- > Percentages of articles with each principle or theme
- Analysis of cross-cultural education critiques, cultural humility model adaptations, and new approaches
