

The importance of researcher profiles

WHAT IS A Researcher Profile?

- · A profile created on a database or academic networking site
- Links you to your work
- Identifies you and your accomplishments
- Ensures you get credit for your research
- Increases citations and impact
- Builds your professional reputation
- Persists over time




WHO NEEDS A Researcher Profile?

- Ask yourself:
 - Do you present as a professional?
 - Are you readily identifiable and distinguishable?
 - When you Google your name in quotes, what do you find?
 - What do you want people to find?
- Remember:
 - Your researcher profile is a public-facing online presence








WHAT SHOULD I LOOK FOR IN A RESEARCHER PROFILE TOOL?

- Will the profile be easy to maintain?
- Is the profile tool widely used? Is it interdisciplinary?
- Can I easily find collaborators?
- Does the profile have networking capabilities?
- Are analytics available to show the impact of my work?
- Will it allow me to upload and share copies of my research?

TIPS & CONSIDERATIONS

- Profiles require updating
- Pick 1-3 and maintain
- Use one personal email address to create accounts and link to professional account





GOOGLE SCHOLAR Key features


- Track citation metrics (h-index, i10-index)
- Explore categories

GOOGLE SCHOLAR Considerations

- Must have, or establish, a Google account
- All information is public (minus personal info, somewhat)
- Automatically updates and counts citations
- Citations count from *all* types of sources (reports, papers, docs not listed in other databases)

GOOGLE SCHOLAR Register

- Login using your Google account
- Click My Profile to create your profile
- Add work:
 - Click + icon > Add article groups or Add articles. This will search for your name as an author
 - Select your publications from the list of articles generated by Google Scholar
 - Google Scholar indexes more publications than databases like Scopus or Web of Science, so the list may include many of your publications
 - Add publications manually if they don't appear in the list

- You must use your true name when creating a profile. Company names and pseudonyms are not allowed
- When register for an account, do not use an email address that is associated with an office, position, or task, such as "marketing@company.com" or "sales@business.org."
- Creating multiple profiles is not allowed.
